Who Qualifies

- Any individual who is or will be enrolled at an accredited Ohio college, university, or technical school may apply.
- The applicant must be enrolled or intend to enroll in a major relating to environmental sciences or environmental education.
- The individual must reside in an OALPRP member community. An agency or individual member within a city or county must have dues paid for the current year. Check with Scholarship Chairperson or local representative.

Winner's Responsibility

Acceptance of this award is also an agreement to allow the use of name, personal information, and/or photos to promote OALPRP.

Selection Criteria

Applications will be judged according to the following criteria:

1. A one page essay of approximately 500 words judged on the basis of originality, creativity, and realistic content. **40%**
2. The amount of community and school involvement with an emphasis on environmental stewardship activities. **40%**
3. A letter of recommendation from a guidance counselor or academic advisor. **20%**
